

# Clearpool Expectations for Teachers and Chaperones

1. Students must always be accompanied by an adult. **THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS RULE.**
2. **NO PETS, NO EXCEPTIONS**
3. The school will assign at least one adult chaperone from the school to each learning group of students. This adult is responsible for getting students to classes and accompanying them during the classes.
4. Clearpool teachers are experts in their area of instruction. We ask that chaperones support them by modeling and managing student behaviors according to their best judgment and to the safety rules and regulations of the Clearpool Education Center (CEC) as described in the orientation and by CEC facilitators.
5. CEC safety rules and regulations prohibit cottage “raids”, “sneak outs” and/or pillow fights.
6. Chaperones will help students to comply with CEC safety rules and regulations in the cottages, including those regarding behavior, food, supervision and clean-up in the cottages.
7. Groups are allowed at the waterfront only if it is a scheduled activity *AND* there is a Clearpool certified lifeguard present.
8. Lifeguards will explain their expectations for waterfront assistance and supervision during their orientation. Please follow all of their directives. Failure to do so will result in closure of the waterfront and cessation of all waterfront activities.
9. The Clearpool Education Center staff works very hard to provide a timely program. Please be on time for classes and meals. This will help to assure a safe and fun experience for everyone!
