

Group Assignment Guidelines

Class Groups

Group size should be about 12 students (never more than 15). Each group must have a chaperone present at all times. We have found that field groups of mixed gender and academic ability are often most successful. Please make an effort to separate students who cause trouble when together, and consider separating best friends as they often learn better when they are not together.

Cabin Groups

Each cabin sleeps 24 students and 4 adults. The adults have two rooms with two single beds in each room. There is one bathroom for the adults to share. These rooms are separated from the students by doors. The students will be in bunk beds. Please refer to the Cottage Planning Sheet for bunk layout. There has to be one chaperone per 10 kids in the cottages.

Meal Tables

If you would like to assign your students to table groups for mealtimes, each table can sit up to 7 students and 1 chaperone. There should be one adult at each table. If you do not assign your students to meal tables, then we will allow them to sit wherever they like and there will still need to be one adult per table.
